- 1. Optimize and renovate 100% of the envelope of all buildings by 2030. 4 action tracks.
- **2.** From today, preserve and increase the current and remaining area of brown and green spaces (61%) on various UNIL sites and improve its ecological quality. 6 action tracks.
- **3.** Provide UNIL with a mandatory Sustainability Charter (tender) regarding the construction and renovation of buildings. 6 action tracks.
- 4. Consume exclusively renewable energy, distributed between on-site autonomous production and/or off-site green production, but in Switzerland and (co)financed by UNIL, by 2050. 9 action tracks.
- **5.** From today, impose a moratorium on the construction of new buildings, except for those already planned that must comply with the charter. *9 action tracks*.
- 6. Encourage the UNIL population to use bicycles (including electric). 7 action tracks.
- 7. Limit the number of people coming to the campus in motorized personal vehicles (thermal and electric) while ensuring accessibility for everyone. 7 action tracks.
- **8.** Reduce the distance traveled by air. 9 action tracks.
- 9. Reduce the distance traveled by individual motorized transport. 2 action tracks.
- 10. Offer healthy and quality food in campus restaurants, cafeterias, and vending machines, following the criteria of the World Health Organization, with the best nutriscore by the fall of 2024. 4 action tracks.
- **11.** Reduce plastic and aluminum packaging. 1 action track.
- **12.** Offer a food selection including organic and seasonal products from Switzerland. 8 action tracks.
- 13. Internalize all catering and grocery services by 2032. 2 action tracks.
- 14. Offer a vegetarian or vegan dish for CHF 3.- for students by the fall of 2024. 2 action tracks.

- **15.** Reduce the weight of total animal-origin foods offered at UNIL from 27% to 5% by the fall of 2028. 5 action tracks.
- **16.** Centralize 95% of purchases (materials, consumables, equipment, furniture) by 2025. 6 action tracks.
- **17.** Inventory 95% of UNIL's equipment and mutualize anything that can be shared (furniture, equipment, consumables, research materials) by 2025. *5 action tracks.*
- **18.** Reduce the mass of new equipment purchased by UNIL (consumable materials, equipment, furniture, etc.) related to all types of laboratory work. *4 action tracks*.
- **19.** From 2030, establish and follow environmental and social criteria defined by an interfaculty commission for 95% of research (all types of research combined). *5 action tracks*.
- **20.** Reduce digital-related waste. 4 action tracks.
- **21.** Reduce the purchase of new electronic equipment. 8 action tracks.
- **22.** Reduce energy consumption related to digital technology (proportionally to the number of UNIL members). *9 action tracks.*
- 23. Directly invest UNIL's fortune in ecological transition. 3 action tracks.
- **24.** Invest 100% of UNIL's fortune in sustainable investments at Banque Cantonale Vaudoise by 2030. *4 action tracks.*
- **25.** Regularly communicate on challenges and measures related to ecological transition to the UNIL community and the general public by 2025. *4 action tracks*.
- **26.** Improve working conditions for the UNIL community and all those involved in its functioning by providing goods and services from 2025. *3 action tracks.*
