Desired profile :

An MA graduate in political sociology, political science, sociology or an equivalent degree, obtained with very good results, who wants to write an original PhD thesis in political sociology. The candidate should have a strong interest for empirical research and scientific writing and possess good skills in qualitative methods (ethnography, life stories ,in depth interviews) and basic knowledge in quantitative methods. Working languages are French and English; fluency in French can be acquired during the 1st year of employment.. German is not required but would be a plus.

Task description :

50% of working time is dedicated to the writing of a doctoral thesis related to the domains of interest of the Research Center on Political Action, University of Lausanne (CRAPUL) <http://www.unil.ch/crapul/home.html>

A maximum of 50% of the regular working hours will be spent assisting with teaching and research tasks at the BA and Master level (teaching activities under a professor's responsibility. Research work that is not linked to personal research and technical or administrative tasks that pertain the department's teaching or research activities.)

- A job in a dynamic research centre (CRAPUL), closely linked to an extended network of other research centre in Europe specialized into social movement studies and political sociology.
