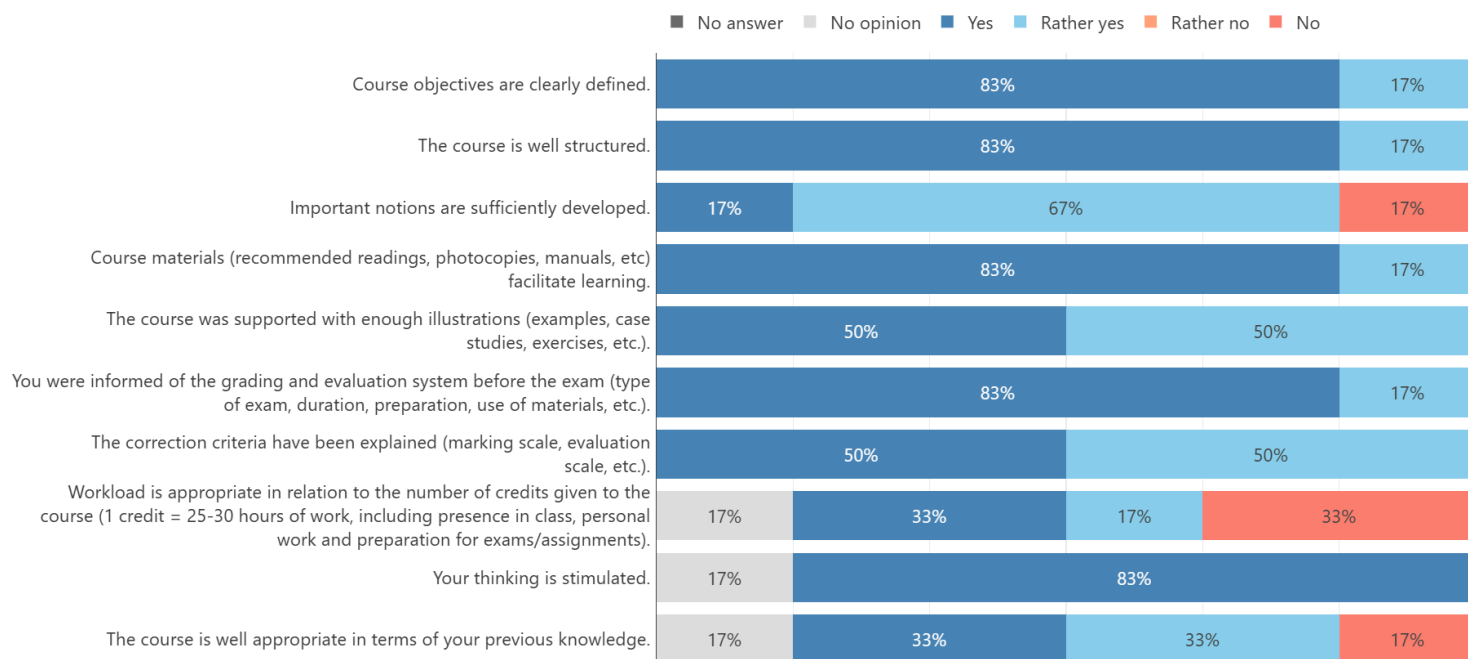

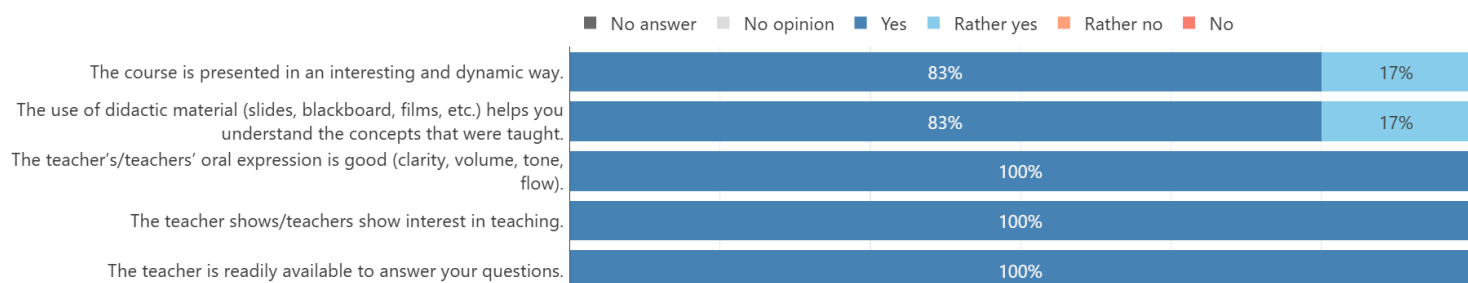

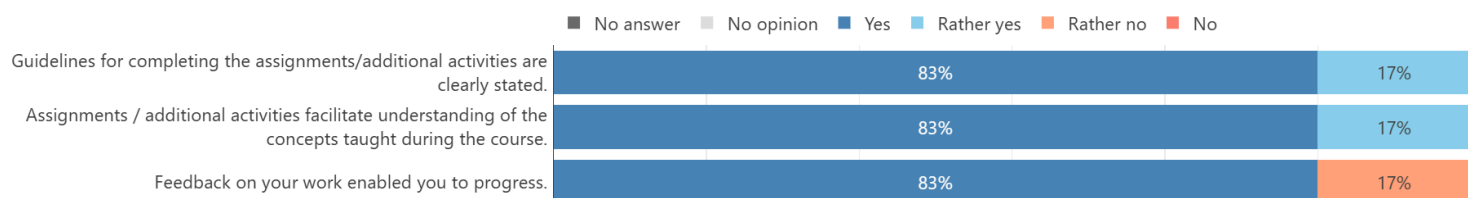
### Organisation of the course



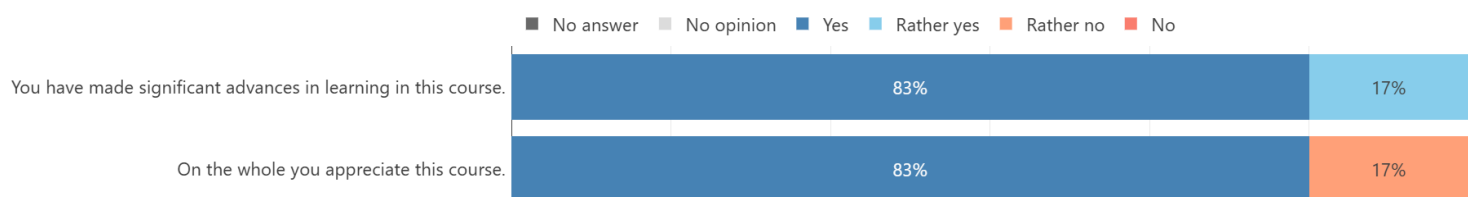
### Presentation of the course and interaction
