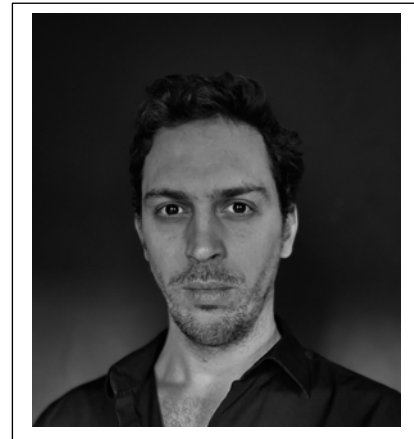


Gonzalo Ana Dobratinich

Biographie

Gonzalo Ana Dobratinich is an Argentine writer based in New York City. He is a professor at New York University (NYU), where he holds a Master of Fine Arts (MFA) in Creative Writing.

He is also a professor at the University of Buenos Aires and a postdoctoral researcher at the National Scientific and Technical Research Council (CONICET), Argentina. He holds a Ph.D. in Law from the University of Buenos Aires and the University of Málaga (Spain), as well as a Master's Degree in Philosophy of Law from the University of Buenos Aires.

With a background in law, literature, philosophy, and technology, his work explores the intersections between language, fiction, justice, and artificial intelligence. He directs research projects and knowledge-transfer and community-engagement programs.
