The person appointed should be committed to excellence in teaching on undergraduate and masters' courses and research supervision. They will be expected to play an active role in the administration of the Department.

Candidates will have a completed PhD in Sociology. Lecturers will be expected to have a developing record of high quality publications that will contribute to the department's research profile as well as relevant teaching and supervision experience at undergraduate and postgraduate levels, and the ability to provide specialist teaching in core Sociology teaching.

The Professor will be expected to offer academic leadership and will already have made an outstanding contribution in research, with a leading international reputation and an excellent record of publications in peer-reviewed journals. They will also demonstrate a proven ability to attract research funding.
