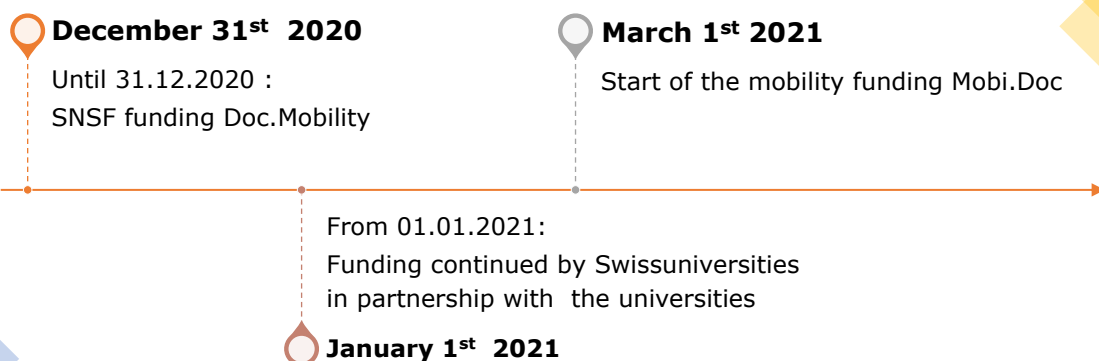

- Research stay abroad
- Duration : 6 months



* with the exception of doctoral candidates funded by the SNSF

Mobi.Doc – requirements



- ✓ Registration as a doctoral student at UNIL for at least 12 months
- ✓ Swiss nationality or valid residence permit

Mobi.Doc deadline-submission-evaluation



Submission and evaluation

- 1st March and 1st September
- Via the platform OPTIMY
- Evaluation by the UNIL Commission for research expertise (CxR)



Funding start date

- Earliest 4 months after the submission deadline

Mobi.Doc Fellowship vs Grant

TWO TYPE OF FUNDING :

- ❖ **Fellowship** : aimed at doctoral students without an employment contract with UNIL or who will interrupt their contract as an assistant during their stay abroad. Covers the personal maintenance of the beneficiary and his/her family
- ❖ **Grant** : aimed at doctoral students who decide not to interrupt their employment contract with UNIL. Contribution to the living expenses and continue to receive their salary.

Mobi.Doc - contribution **FELLOWSHIP** (for 6 months)

- **Basic amount :**
CHF 20'000 - 32'750
(depending on country & family status)
- **Child allowance :**
CHF 3'000 per child
- **Travel allowance :**
Return trip (incl.partner/children)
- **Registration, congress, research costs :**
Maximum CHF 1'500
