







## SYNAPSY NETWORK TRAINING on TRANSLATIONAL PSYCHIATRY

#### **Summary**

The course is an initiative of the Synapsy network and its members. In several modules, students will learn about various topics in translational neuropsychiatry, from synapses to networks, get to know about neuro(a)typics and techniques of investigations, intervention approaches and outcomes. Each module contains 3-4 sessions where researchers active in the NeuroLeman Network will present their work, ranging from methods to applications, in animals, humans and in silico.

The course is arranged in a modular fashion and (mostly) held online. Participants can choose the modules they want, but the introductory **Module 1** is **MANDATORY** and will take place as **IN-PERSON** half-day session so that participants get to know each other.
