

## User agreement and terms of use of the Workplace Interpersonal Perception Skill (WIPS) test for academic research purposes

The Workplace Interpersonal Perception Skill test (WIPS; Dael, Schlegel, Weaver, Ruben, & Schmid Mast, 2022) is an online performance-based test that measures individual differences in interpersonal accuracy broadly, covering different nonverbal channels (face, body, voice) and multiple content domains (personality, behavioral intentions, status, interpersonal attitudes, thoughts and feelings). The WIPS comprises 41 brief video segments with and without sound from three types of role-played workplace interactions: a recruiter-candidate negotiation, a helpdesk trouble-shooting scenario, and a company team meeting. Each segment is paired with a multiple-choice question. The WIPS takes 20 minutes to complete.

The development of the WIPS was supported by the Swiss Innovation Agency, CTI Innosuisse project nr. 28376.1 PFES-ES. The WIPS is freely accessible for academic research purposes only, as per this User Agreement. ### The WIPS is available for academic research purposes free of charge under the following Terms of the User Agreement:

1. The undersigned researcher requesting use of the WIPS confirms to hold an academic appointment within its institution and will be responsible for the supervision of the research conducted with the WIPS. Every collaborator using the WIPS has to be listed in the request form (name and academic affiliation), including those of undergraduate and graduate students. The undersigned researcher will inform the listed collaborators of the general conditions for the use of the WIPS and procures that such listed collaborators will comply with this User Agreement.
2. A short description of the project involving the WIPS (1 page) (which shall be treated as confidential) must be submitted to the UNIL-HEC ([marianne.schmidmast@unil.ch](mailto:marianne.schmidmast@unil.ch)) prior to the study together with this User Agreement. The WIPS may only be used within the scope of the project and after written prior approval by UNIL-HEC.
3. Every new project using the WIPS or the involvement of other researchers requires a new application.
4. The WIPS will only be used for academic research purposes, within the scope of the project described as per point 2 above. Any commercial use of the WIPS is excluded. Please contact Vima Link SA at [sales@vima.swiss](mailto:sales@vima.swiss) for any request regarding commercial and non-academic professional purposes.
5. The WIPS must be cited in each publication involving its use in the following way Dael, N., Schlegel, K., Weaver, A. E., Ruben, M. A., & Schmid Mast, M. (2022). 6. The researcher using the WIPS acknowledges the confidentiality of the WIPS (including the WIPS' source code and object code) and shall at all times keep all information, either written or oral, and documentation, received from UNIL-HEC in connection with the WIPS (including the WIPS itself), strictly confidential (such information, documentation being referred to as the "Confidential Information"). In particular, the researcher using the WIPS undertakes (i) not to use any Confidential Information relating to the WIPS for any purpose other than solely in performance of research project under this User Agreement, (ii) in particular not to display the WIPS source code and object code, or grant access to the WIPS application in any form, in a public space (internet, in proceedings or articles) and (iii) not to disclose at any time any Confidential Information to any third party, either directly or indirectly. However, the researcher using the WIPS shall be entitled to disclose the Confidential Information to (a) the listed collaborators to the extent necessary for the proper use of the WIPS as per this User Agreement, and (b) to show examples of the WIPS (never in its entirety, but limited fractions of the WIPS only) in conference talks, poster presentations, scientific publications, or public lectures.
7. Without prejudice to the rights granted under the CTI Project Agreement, Vima Link SA is the sole and exclusive owner and/or holder of all patent applications, trademarks, copyrights, and other proprietary rights in and with respect to the WIPS test material (the "Vima's Intellectual Property Rights"). The Vima's Intellectual Property Rights remain with Vima Link SA. The researcher using the WIPS acknowledges and agrees that he does not, by virtue of this User Agreement or otherwise, obtain, or become entitled to claim any of the Vima's Intellectual Property Rights, except the right to use the WIPS as expressly granted under this User Agreement. The researcher using the WIPS will not grant nor purport to grant any right or licence to use the Vima's Intellectual Property Rights to any third party.
8. UNIL-HEC and Vima Link SA decline any responsibility for faulty use that damages the WIPS files or that impairs their quality, for any consequences of faulty use and analysis of the WIPS, and for any undesired results following the use of the WIPS.
9. The use of the WIPS after one year starting from the signature date requires a new application.
